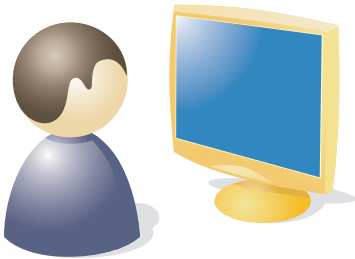


Office Online Etiquette
